Jacqueline Bouvier Kennedy Onassis: The Untold Story by Barbara Leaming (2014). Well-researched, readable biography. The first explore Jackie's struggle with post-traumatic stress disorder following JFK's assassination.

Grace and Power: The Private World of the Kennedy White House by Sally Bedell-Smith (2005). Interweaves Jackie and Jack's history with a political history of the Kennedy administration. Fascinating.

Jacqueline Kennedy: The White House Years by Hamish Bowles, Arthur M. Schlesinger and Rachel L. Mellon (2001). Stunning coffee-table book overviewing her White House years. Written to accompany the 2001 Metropolitan Museum of Art exhibition.

Jackie: Behind the Myth (DVD), by PBS DVD Video (2003). A nicely thorough look at her life using historic footage and interviews. The readings from her diaries can be distracting, but overall a well-done video of her life.

Mrs. Kennedy and Me by Clint Hill and Lisa McCubbin (2012). Jackie Kennedy's personal Secret Service agent wrote this bestselling memoir of his years working with Jackie.
